<div>Details of Disappearance</div> <div>The Banner-Journal, May 1963. Cannot link directly to it as it is in the library database: Malchow was down on the island beneath the Black River bridge... Malchow indicated he was thinking of "trying" the channel to see how swift the current was. Mr. Johnson is inclined to think Mr. Malchow may have drowned. There have been reports Malchow has been seen at the nearby Indian Mission exit. Sheriff Julian Larkin said no one has been positive about it and the speculation is if he went there at all he would not remain there this length of time. Another report has been he was seen at Hank's Tavern in downtown Black River Falls.
